### Entry Confirmation and Late Cancellation

### Paddock Access

Classic Bike Track Days hired the Anglesey Circuit for a track day on the Friday and the CRMC sessions are sold out.

First Practice/Race:.....Saturday: 9.30am..... Sunday Racing from noon, (No Sunday morning testing at this meeting)

Trophy presentation:.....Sunday evening approx 20 mins after completion of racing.

Race Engine Running times: .....Saturday 9.20am – 6.00pm Sunday 11.50am – 6.00pm

Riders Briefing:..... Via written notes on the CRMC website and social media 5-7 days before the event with a hard copy version available from race office.

Parade riders briefing .....Saturday at 9.00am in the briefing room near the race office and repeated at 9.00am

Sunday for Sunday only paraders .

### Signing-on

Signing on for the CRMC meeting will be in the Race Office located on the ground floor of the pit lane complex. See above for opening times. When you sign-on for the meeting please present your 2021 ACU licence (or DVLA licence for paraders). You will receive your technical control card/practice pass when you sign-on. This pass also indicates which practice session(s) you have been allocated.

**Note:** parade riders over 70 now require an ACU parade licence.

### Noise Control

Every machine must be silenced to comply with the ACU limit of 105 dBa and will need to pass noise testing before their first race. Noise testing will be available Friday afternoon and from 9.25am Saturday morning. The noise testing routine of a 105db limit with no allowances that commenced at Castle Combe will continue at Croft. Riders are recommended to noise test Friday afternoon where possible to ease the pressure on Saturday morning.

### Technical Control (Scrutineering)

- Location of Technical Control: The building half way up the paddock road on the right hand side.
- When you present the bike to technical control please:
- Have your technical control card and machine eligibility certificate with you.
- Have your machine numbered for racing with ACU compliant numbers.
- Sidecars to present their machines with the fairing removed.

If you have an eligibility query, please contact the relevant Eligibility Officer listed on the CRMC web site

Machine Stickers: Old CRMC stickers for Tech Control, noise testing and camera approval are congesting the fairings on some bikes and causing problems and delays at Race Assembly. Please ensure that old stickers are removed before presenting your pride and joy to the Tech Control Officials.

### Championship Points Reminder:

- The final two rounds of the Championship at Croft will have a points allocation exactly the same as all the other rounds.
- Championship points are not awarded for the Race of the Year events on the Sunday.
- All points scored are to count for the 2021 CRMC Championships.

- In the event that the full Croft programme is not possible, then the Race of the Year trophies will be awarded to the winner of the last race in 2021 for the class in question, whether it be on the Saturday or Sunday.
- There will be the normal Prize Presentation on Saturday evening at Croft, and the Race of the Year trophies presented at the CRMC Dinner Dance on December 4th.

### **Paddock Parking**

Please do not park behind the pit lane garages unless you have pre booked a garage.

### **Medical Centre**

Should you need medical attention or require being passed fit to ride, the doctors are in the Medical Centre that can be found in the portacabin on the left as you enter the paddock.

### **Fallers**

Any faller will have their machine taken to Technical Control. The rider must first see the doctor at the medical centre and then bring the Fitness to Race Form to the Clerk of the Course in Race Control. A machine release card will be issued, which allows the bike to be released from Technical Control. Bikes will not be released without one.

### **On board Cameras**

Any rider wishing to carry on board video equipment needs written permission from the CRMC. Forms are available in the Technical Control Bay.

### **Returning Race of the Year Trophies**

If you won a race of the year trophy in 2019 or received a committee nominated trophy and have not yet returned it, please arrange to bring it to Croft and leave it with Anji in the Race Office.

### **Grid positions**

Grid positions for the first race will be determined from fastest lap times set in timed practice Saturday morning. Fastest laps in the **second and third** (R.o.Y.) races of the weekend will be set from fastest laps set in the first race. ACU Championship grids will be produced from the latest championship positions. The Championship leader on pole, second in the table in second place and so on. Riders may opt to start at the back of the grid if they wish, by consulting with the race assembly marshal.

### **Transponders**

If you have hired a transponder it will be issued ready charged at signing-on, in exchange for your race licence. Mounting brackets are available from race office. You must have your transponder fitted during practice and racing. If you encounter problems with your own transponder please see CRMC Race Office for a temporary replacement.

### **Trophy Presentation**

Saturday's trophy presentation will be held approx 20 minutes after racing finishes on Saturday evening at the Technical Control Bay

### **Tyre Warmers**

All competitors are reminded that the use of tyre warmers is not permitted at any time during CRMC race meetings.

### **Check list of items not to forget!!**

- Admission tickets
- ACU Competition licence (Without it you may end up not being able to race).
- DVLA Licence for Paraders without a competition or over 70 parading licence.
- Eligibility certificate.
- A Fully charged transponder (Unless Parading or hiring a CRMC transponder)
- Fire Extinguisher
